Your Maths challenge is to practise your adding and subtracting. I would like you to go for a walk down the road with your grown up and look at numbers in your environment such as house numbers, street signs, car registration plates etc. Can you add 1 and then 10 to the number? Can you take away 1 or a 10 from the number?

For example spot number 47. Add 1 = 48 Add 10 = 57 subtract 1 = 46 subtract 10 = 37

Challenge yourself and add 20? = 67 or even add 30? Good luck!
