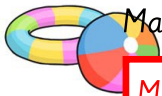


Dear Parents/Carers,



We hope you all had a wonderful Easter holiday. The children have come back with a fantastic attitude towards their learning and are very excited about our trip to the seaside at Weston-Super-

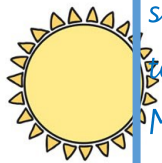

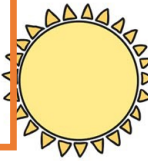


English - We have started a new unit called Little Red Reading Hood. We have had great fun reading books all around school and got to read them in the staffroom! We have also visited the Forest School at Ernesford Grange. We are working on the vocabulary: noun, verb, adjective, adverb, proper noun and preposition.



Theme - Our summer topic is 'We do like to be beside the seaside'. We shall be finding out about the history of the seaside and how it has changed over time. We will be using our geography skills to study Weston Super Mare and compare it to Coventry.

We are also going to use our maths skills to help us find out about seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and Australia and learn about hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
