- 5. To use gestures to create a secret mission ending.
- 6. To perform a secret agent dance with control, precision and skill.

Assessment Overview

Unit Focus

Work to develop a solo secret agent phrase and explore relationship variations through trio dance, such as action and reaction. Practice and perform a variety of different formations.

Key Questions

- 1. What is a secret agent? What are their characteristics?
- 2. How can I use action and reaction with my group?
- 3. How can I interpret and appreciate another groups dance?

Concepts

Relationships – When dancers work together, they can make sequences more interesting by using ideas like action and reaction. In this unit, we explore combat, attacking and defending, and how dancers respond to each other's movements.
